World Neurology is the quarterly publication of the World Federation of Neurology and active recruitment for a new Editor of *World Neurology* is now in progress. Dr. Jagjit Chopra has served with distinction as Editor for the past seven years and his successor will assume the editorship at a time to be negotiated. A new tabloid format with improved scientific content is currently in preparation.

World Neurology provides a vital link for all neurologists world-wide in providing current news of the activities of the World Federation of Neurology and the quadrennial World Congress of Neurology. It provides important information about the educational and scientific programs of national neurological societies and the individual achievements of neurologists. The future objectives of *World Neurology* will emphasize new and emerging clinical and basic neuroscientific reports in the neurological literature and will review and highlight the major lectures and research presentations at recent neurological meetings world-wide. A major publishing company will be the publisher and will provide professional writers and broad editorial support to the new Editor and the Editorial Board.
